

#### **Crime Statistics**

The twelve months running total to the end of May, 2016, shows an increase of only one over the position at the end of last year, which was the lowest rate over the five year reporting period. Appendix 1 summarises the movement monthly. There have been 8 crimes reported in the last three months and half of these were outside of the village, "near to the Ferry Terminal, Waterfoot and the B5320". Appendix 2 details the trend over six years.
